Misteria Paschalia

13 - 20 April 2025

Misteria Paschalia is one of the most important early music festivals in Europe, organized by KBF since 2004 during Holy Week.

Eight days, ten exceptional locations, and dozens of artistic events in Kraków, Tyniec, and Wieliczka from April 13 to 20, 2025 – this is what the 22nd edition of the Misteria Paschalia Festival looks like. As one of Europe's most significant early music festivals, it offers a unique journey through the sounds of past centuries. Under the artistic direction of Vincent Dumestre, audiences will experience a rich program featuring both renowned masterpieces and rediscovered works.

This year's edition will bring together over 100 artists from several European countries, offering not only mesmerizing concerts but also events that deepen the understanding of early music and historical instruments. All performances will take place in Kraków's most beautiful venues, merging the city's historical heritage with world-class musical interpretations.

Concert: W.A. Mozart's Requiem

1 April 2025

Krakow Opera, Lubicz 48

The Requiem is a Mass for the dead (Missa pro defunctis), traditionally sung on All Souls' Day and during funeral ceremonies. Its name comes from the first words of the introit Requiem aeternam ("Eternal rest").

Mozart's Requiem in D-minor is the most famous composition of its kind. Written in the final months of the composer's life, its completion was interrupted by his untimely death in 1791. The last section Mozart worked on was the Lacrimosa from the Dies irae sequence. The piece was later completed by four composers from his inner circle, with Franz Xaver Süssmayr making the most significant contribution.





Krakow - at the crossroads of cultures and religions.


Pilgrimages, commonly referred to as annual parish feasts on the feast day of the local church's patron saint, during which one can obtain an indulgence (the remission of temporal punishment for sins), are also festivals and fairs held in the vicinity of churches. Using a few examples of Krakow's parish pilgrimages, this presentation will attempt to answer questions such as: What changes have occurred over the centuries that led to the gradual incorporation of secular elements into strictly religious celebrations, eventually resulting in the complete dominance of festive and commercial aspects? What distinguished the Krakow spring pilgrimages in the past, and what did they mean for the residents of Krakow and its surroundings? What happened to the most famous ones, such as Emauzy and Rękawka? To what extent is their contemporary form rooted in Krakow's traditions?


This Saturday, April 12, Kraków's art-house cinemas will open their doors to all film enthusiasts!
