Month of Krakowianki 2025

March 1 - 31, 2025

Krakow Women's Comber

February 8 - March 1, 2025

Krzysztofory Palace, Main Square 35

Originating in the Middle Ages, this once extremely popular carnival tradition of the market women from Kraków's suburbs was celebrated for centuries during the Shrovetide period. During this time, the female vendors would symbolically take control of the city and organize a feast on Kraków's Main Square, filled with food, wine, music, and dancing. They would "kidnap" men on the streets, compelling them to join the festivities or buy their freedom with a gift.

The main theme of the third edition of this event is Woman as a River. Through a series of traditional singing and dancing workshops, culminating in an open Śpiewogranie (Song Gathering) at Stary Kleparz, participants will explore the connections between the significance of this celebration for both historical and contemporary residents of Kraków. The program also includes a lecture by Dr. Andrzej Szoka. The event will conclude on March 1 with a colorful parade from Stary Kleparz (starting at 2:00 PM), passing through Szczepański Square to the Main Square, where an outdoor dance party will take place.

Ladies, Intellectuals, and Rebels – Women of Podgórze – City Walk

Some of them are well-documented, while of others, only names or brief mentions remain.

Together, we'll visit former girls' schools and learn about the first female teachers, as well as the brave young women who went to great lengths to gain an education. We'll meet the grand ladies of Podgórze, the first female writers and a photographer, and we'll also take a glimpse into the darker, working-class world.

On March 1, 2025, the QUEEN SYMPHONICALLY project will return to Kraków! One year after the last concert, Queen Symfonicznie will perform again with a full orchestra at the ICE Kraków Congress Centre, this time featuring the Hollyłódź Film Orchestra alongside the classic ensemble. During the two-part concert, over 50 artists will take the stage to perform the greatest hits of Queen. The concert will begin at 7:30 PM.

These extraordinary concerts combine the immortal music of QUEEN with symphonic arrangements performed by the Alla Vienna choir and orchestra, captivating fans of the legendary band for thirteen years. QUEEN SYMPHONICALLY has become an absolute phenomenon – initially planned as a one-time performance, it evolved into a grand concert tour in the largest venues across the country. With over 400 concerts to date, around 300,000 spectators have attended, with every show sold out. Operatic Power of Hits




This event is held in conjunction with the exhibition "Osobno, ale razem" (Separate, but Together).



Covering several of the biggest Polish cities, the "unplugged" concert cycle has become a true tradition, celebrated annually by tens of thousands of fans across the country.
