SILENCE Music Festival

3 September - 4 October 2026

Unconventional, unpredictable, untamed... Absolutely! This autumn, the festival, whose inventiveness knows no bounds, returns to the Radziwiłł Palace in Balice and other venues across Kraków.

The programme „24 sorrows are our ordinary day” will feature 24-part compositions by Chopin, Bach, Paganini and Debussy, scheduled across 24 hours, as well as a live massage. „Snails à la Polish” will combine music and culinary arts, all, naturally, served with a French twist. In „Homeless God”, Schubert’s masterpiece Winterreise will meet rap, punk and techno. The production will be directed by Kamil Białaszczek, one of the most prominent voices of the young generation of theatre artists. The premiere of „Growing into silence” by Estera Wityńska will also take place during the festival. As the work incorporates the idea of its own „ageing”, cellist Barbara Łypik-Sobaniec and 13-year-old acrobatic dancer Alicja Południak will perform it at 17 consecutive editions of the festival, until the dancer turns 30.

The SILENCE line-up will also include pianists Yehuda Prokopowicz and Giorgi Gigashvili, performing the recitals „Chapeau bas!” and „GIGASH!”, violinist Robert Bachara, harpsichordist Aleksander Mock, as well as the Royal String Quartet, Malawski Trio and Mauris Ensemble. The audience will also have an opportunity to contribute to the festival. As part of the „Needs Renovation” initiative, participants will be invited to take part in a collective cleaning of a Krall & Seidler grand piano dating from 1849.

Znachor (Quack Doctor)

3, 4 and 5 September 2026, 7:00 p.m. and 6:00 p.m.

Malopolska Garden of the Arts, ul. Rajska 12

Znachor, a quintessential Polish melodrama directed by Jakub Roszkowski, is being staged at the Juliusz Słowacki Theatre.

Professor Rafał Wilczur, the famous Warsaw surgeon, or Antoni Kosiba, the village quack? A colourful Warsaw from the interwar period, or a poor village on the borderlands? Two worlds. And two people who – it would seem – are completely different. This one's better. And the other is a worse one. But which is which? Do we have to choose? I'd rather not...

Znachor is a quintessential Polish melodrama. First read, then watched on screen in film adaptations to this day. Kazimierz Junosza-Stępowski and Jerzy Bińczycki, in the roles of Wilczur/Kosiba, captivate, move and leave a lasting impression. A memory, which, after all, their hero loses. His memory, which may be his greatest asset, but which could also become his downfall.

Marzena Kolarz, 'Hands, Head, Heart' – a photography exhibition

3 September 2026, 6:00 p.m.

Nowa Huta Cultural Centre, Al. Jana Pawła II 232

"The title of the exhibition, *Hands, Head, Heart*, refers to my way of thinking about photography. I regard it not merely as a medium, a technique or an activity, but as an equal partner in the creative process. For me, photography is a language, an external memory, a tool for understanding, a form of expression without words, and a way of coming to terms with difficult experiences.

In my doctoral thesis, I compared photography to the human body, and more specifically to three of its parts: the head, the heart and the hand. To me, the head represents a thought, an idea, a concept and the process of imagination. The heart is associated with emotions, sensitivity, intuition and the connection with the audience, but also with delving into one's inner self and discovering hidden experiences. Hands represent technique, knowledge, agency, the physicality of the process, touch, gesture, chemistry, the imprint, the surface and the material existence of the painting. I believe that it is only a balance between these three areas that enables the world of photography to function effectively. I also seek this balance in my own practice – between idea and matter, between the composition of the image and chance, between creation and memory, between vision and emotion," says Marzena Kolarz, the artist.

Professor Brian Cox – Emergence

Following the global success of the 'Horizons' shows, which were seen by almost half a million people worldwide, including over 4,000 in Warsaw and Poznań, Professor Brian Cox presents the premiere of 'Emergence'.

Brian Cox: "Creating 'Emergence' was a great pleasure for me – it's the most ambitious production I've ever written. I was extremely fortunate to work with a wonderful team of scientists, musicians, filmmakers and graphic designers to bring together cosmology, biology, philosophy and history on the largest and most state-of-the-art LED screen, with the best sound system and lighting I could find. I hope the performance will be a multifaceted experience for the audience – and that everyone, whether they love science, music or history, or simply appreciate the beauty of nature, will come away with something new to think about."

Brian Cox is an English astrophysicist and theoretical physicist. He is best known as the presenter of science programmes produced by the BBC, and is the author of numerous popular science books and nearly a thousand scientific publications. He has been associated with scientific institutions such as CERN and DESY for many years, and is the recipient of numerous awards and honours.

He is one of the world's most recognisable scientists, known for his ability to explain complex scientific concepts in a way that is accessible to a wide audience.

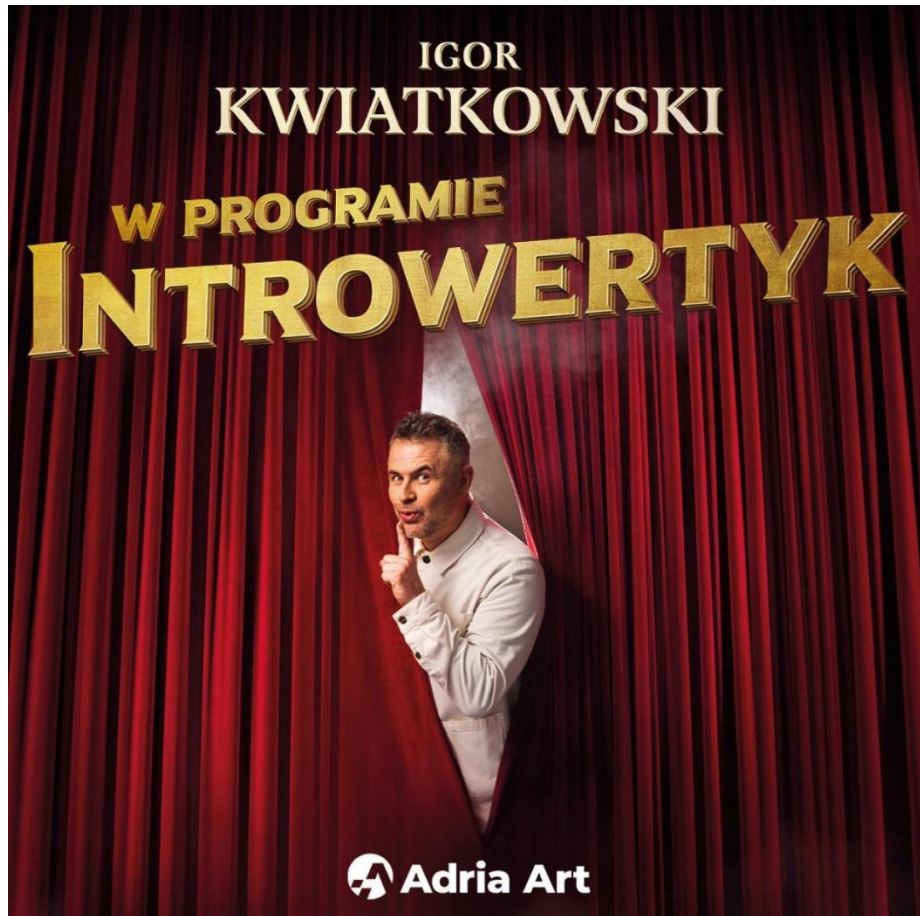

Harvest Festival 2026

Pumpkins from Igołomia-Wawrzeńczyce, lavender and handmade crafts from Biskupice, bobbin lace from Zabierzów, and even products made by the Hospitaller Brothers from Konary near Mogilany – all of these are signs that guests from the municipalities belonging to the Kraków Metropolis Association are coming to Wesoła.

It is a special occasion, taking place just once a year: a celebration of the gifts of the land at the end of summer and an opportunity to discover the results of local craftsmanship in the municipalities surrounding Kraków. Visitors will be able to see, touch, taste and smell the products and traditions of the region.

This year, Harvest Festival will take place on Sunday, 20 September. At individual stands, the whole family will be able to discover colourful stories from areas particularly rich in local traditions. Artistic performances and numerous workshops will add to the experience, including culinary workshops hosted by representatives of Wieliczka and activities organised together with Niepołomice Cultural Centre, where participants will prepare flowers for traditional Kraków wreaths.

The Skawina Wild Education Zone will invite visitors to solve “herbal riddles”. There will also be an opportunity to try starting a fire using a fire striker. On stage, audiences will see the Zagórzanie Song and Dance Ensemble and the Modlniczanki Rural Housewives’ Circle.

An interactive festival game prepared by the organisers will encourage visitors to visit all the exhibitors. There will also be an opportunity to attend a panel discussion on food security and the importance of local products and short supply chains.

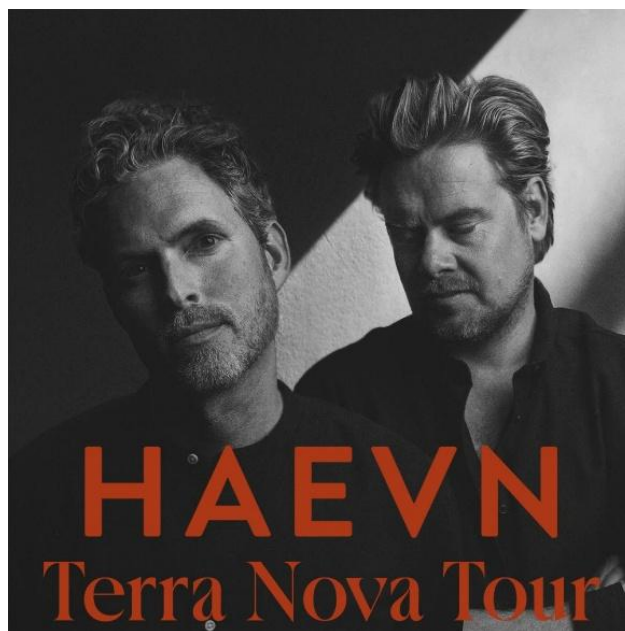

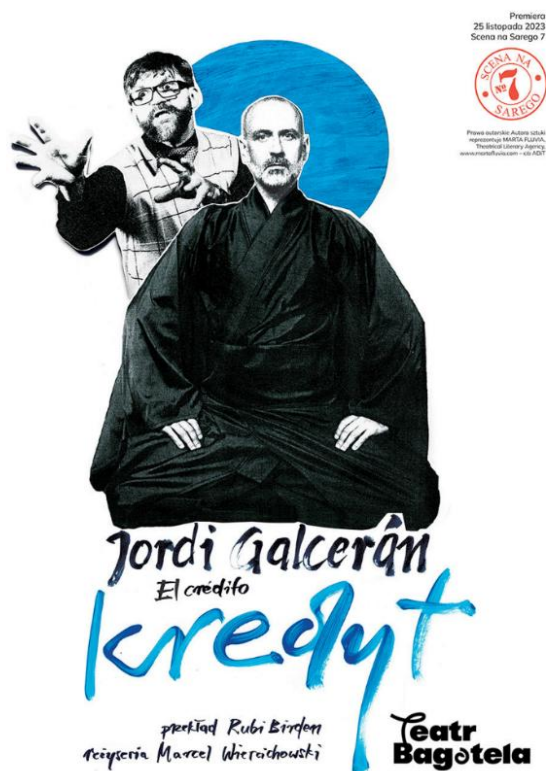

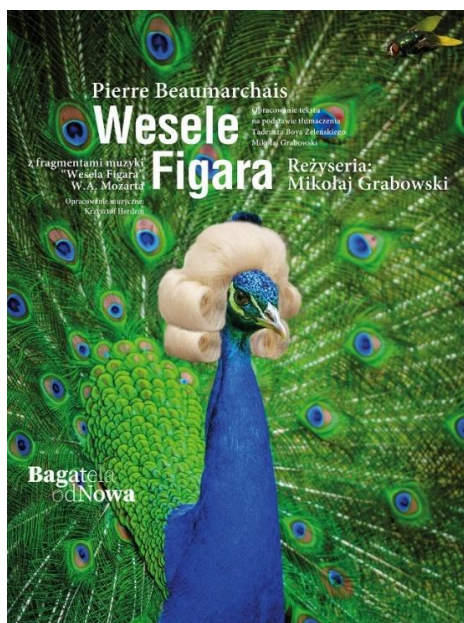

The play is enhanced by the actors' costumes, intricately designed by costume designer Zuzanna Markiewicz.
